Marco Riemann, born in 1977 in Frankfurt/Main is living in Vienna/Austria since 2007. He made his first experiences with electronic music at the age of 20. He could show his first success with the release of the EP named “Undefined Emotionz” on Steve Bug’s label Pokerflat – Recordings in the year 2000. Another EP release on Pokerflat named “Inflexible” was released in the year 2001. In the same year the release on Bellaphon of the remix of the track “Ficken” followed, the track was dedicated to his friend and musician Jürgen Reinecke aka “Superflausch”. Then Marco started to focus on his study of Electrical Engineering, he graduated as engineer in 2005. In 2007 he moved to Vienna as he got an engagement as acoustic engineer at a popular Austrian microphone & headphone company. The deep connection to electronic club-music remained. He continued producing music. In 2009 he decided to found his own label named “imola” to produce his own music and the music of his musical peers.
